

## NEW GRID



### **PLAN**

Government proposing a power grid to transmit about 46,000MW from the North-East and Bhutan to the rest of India at a cost of Rs46,000 crore. The project will use a public-private partnership model.

### **CAPACITY**

The total hydropower generation potential of the North-East, including Bhutan, is about 58,000MW. Local demand is expected to go up to 12,000MW.

### **EXPANSION**

This is in addition to a national transmission grid being planned to double India's transmission capacity to 37,150MW at a cost of Rs14 trillion.
