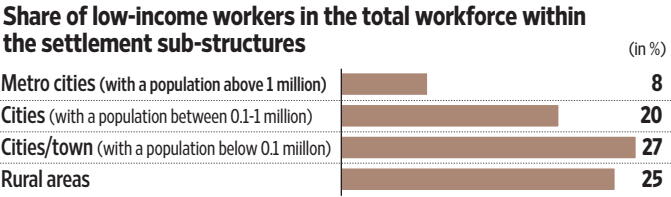
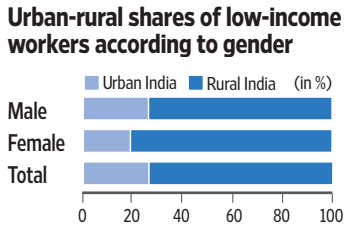
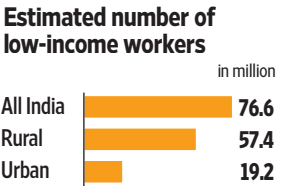
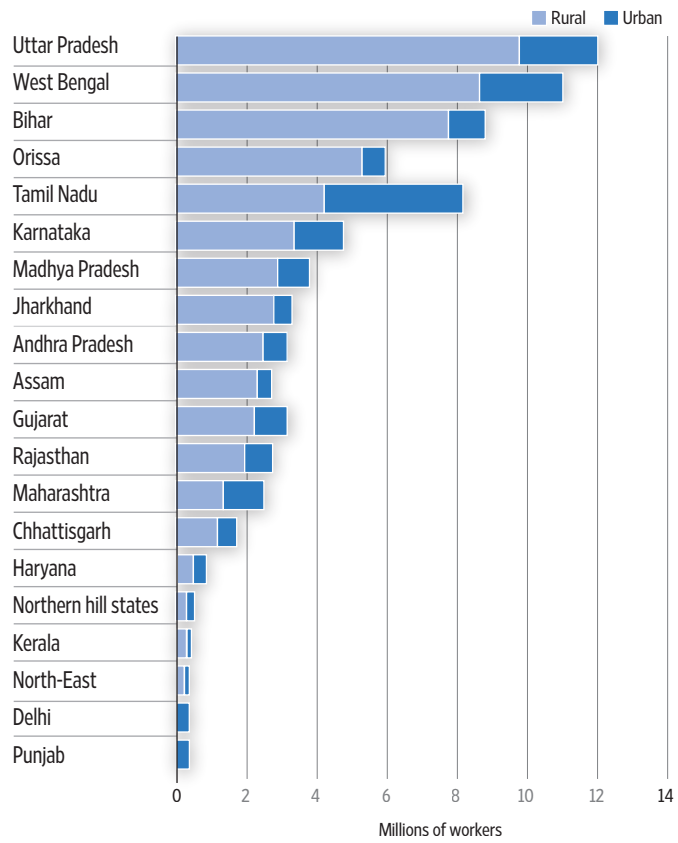


Low-income workforce

To provide the numerical context of low-income workforce, Mint used data and analysis from the Invest India Incomes and Savings Survey 2007, produced by IIMS Dataworks. The survey provides the first 360-degree view of the financial behaviour and future investment intentions of the Indian workforce. According to the survey, there are 321 million paid workers in India. Mint featured key findings from the survey through July last year in a series called India Unveiled.
