## 1 Lloyd Blankfein

chairman and CEO of Goldman Sachs, for telling the Sunday Times of London that he was just a banker doing "God's work".

founder of Satyam Computer Services, for overstating Satyam's profits over several years and creating a fictitious cash balance of more than \$1 billion.

## 8 R Allen Stanford

for misappropriating money made from selling \$7 billion worth of certificates of deposit through his Stanford International Bank.

## 2 John Thain

then CEO of Merrill Lynch, for pushing through \$3.62 billion in bonuses for his executives last December, rather than waiting until January.

a Minnesota businessman, for allegedly orchestrating a \$3.5 billion fraud.

CEO of CDR Financial Products, a municipal bond brokerage, for rigging auctions.
