

GROWING DEMAND

- December 2009 freight demand showed a **24.4%** improvement on December 2008 with a load factor of **54.1%**.
- Asia-Pacific carriers accounted for at least **60%** of the increase in international airfreight markets over the past 12 months—outperforming their **45%** market share.
- European carriers remain **20%** below 2008 peak levels reflecting the glacial pace of economic recovery in Europe compared to Asia-Pacific.
- West Asian carriers and Latin American carriers are smaller market participants, but ended the year at better than peak levels by **7%** and **21%** respectively.
